**CAUTION:** - Section 16 (1) of the Saint Christopher and Nevis Act (No. 1 of 1984 provides that:-

"Any person who for the purpose of procuring anything to be done or not to be done under this Act or under Chapter 8 of the Constitution makes any statement which he knows to be false in a material particular or recklessly makes a statement which is false in a material particular shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction thereof by a court of summary jurisdiction to a fine of five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months or to both such fine and imprisonment."

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES:**

This application is to be made by the following persons:

A person who is married to a citizen or a person who is married to a Commonwealth citizen who is ordinarily resident in Saint Christopher and Nevis and has been so resident for a period of fourteen years immediately preceding the date of the application by a person who is married to a person who, having been a citizen has renounced his or her citizenship, would have become a citizen by virtue of Section 90 of the Constitution, or a person who became a citizen by virtue of Section 90 of the Constitution, but whose marriage to that person has been terminated by dissolution at any time before 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1983 after having subsisted for at least three years.

- \$1,000.00 if married after 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1983
- HIV test result
- Two (2) passport sized photos of applicant
- Police Certification ( from country of residence for past 3 months)
