CAUTION: - Section 16 (1) of the Saint Christopher and Nevis Act (No. 1 of 1984 provides that:-

“Any person who for the purpose of procuring anything to be done or not to be done under this Act or under Chapter 8 of the Constitution makes any statement which he knows to be false in a material particular or recklessly makes a statement which is false in a material particular shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction thereof by a court of summary jurisdiction to a fine of five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.”

EXPLANATORY NOTES:

This application is to be made by the following persons:

A person who is married to a citizen or a person who is married to a Commonwealth citizen who is ordinarily resident in Saint Christopher and Nevis and has been so resident for a period of fourteen years immediately preceding the date of the application by a person who is married to a person who, having been a citizen has renounced his or her citizenship, would have become a citizen by virtue of Section 90 of the Constitution, or a person who became a citizen by virtue of Section 90 of the Constitution, but whose marriage to that person has been terminated by dissolution at any time before 19th September, 1983 after having subsisted for at least three years.
